

## OHIO BOARD OF REGENTS

Agenda Item 3.13 Consideration of the recommendations developed in response to the studies mandated by sections of 209.64.96, 209.65.03 and 209.64.99 of Amended Substitute House Bill 66 of the 126<sup>th</sup> General Assembly.

### **RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Amended Substitute House Bill 66, the state's biennial budget act for fiscal years 2006 and 2007, directs the Ohio Board of Regents to conduct certain studies in consultation with representatives of the higher education community; and

WHEREAS, section 209.64.96 of Amended Substitute House Bill 66 calls for a study on the feasibility of distributing State Share of Instruction funds based on campus administrative and operational efficiency; and

WHEREAS, section 209.65.03 of Amended Substitute House Bill 66 calls for a study on the feasibility of providing incentives for certificate and associate degrees; and

WHEREAS, section 209.64.99 of Amended Substitute House Bill 66 calls for a study on the feasibility of distributing State Share of Instruction funds based on the number of degrees and certificates awarded; and

WHEREAS, a separate and comprehensive study of each mandate has been conducted by a subcommittee of the State Share of Instruction Consultation; and

WHEREAS, this subcommittee has developed specific and separate recommendations for each required study, which have been submitted to and accepted by the State Share of Instruction Consultation.

WHEREAS, the Higher Education Funding Commission will review these recommendations as they relate to the SSI as well as other issues and initiatives, and the impact these will have on students, institutions, and sectors.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED: Upon the recommendation of the Chancellor and with the concurrence of the Resources & System Efficiency Committee of the Ohio Board of Regents, that the recommendations, as described in the attached documents and made a part hereof, are hereby approved.
