Agenda Item 3.1 Release of Technology Initiatives Funds

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Amended Substitute House Bill 640 (state capital budget bill) appropriated \$10,000,000 for Technology Initiatives Program awards to be used by the Board of Regents to award grants to publicly-assisted institutions of higher education in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, campuses could self-select to participate in two grant competitions which are part of the Technology Initiatives Program awards: Development or Enhancement of Content and Collaborative Student Services with \$6,000,000 designated for the Development or Enhancement of Content projects and \$4,000,000 designated for the Collaborative Student Services projects; and

WHEREAS, a review process was established and implemented to distribute the money for these two competitions which incorporated a rigorous review of proposals submitted by colleges and universities by a panel of state and national experts in distance education and student services; and

WHEREAS, the review panel has recommended 26 Development or Enhancement of Content awards and 12 Collaborative Student Services awards for a total of \$10,000,000 (list appended).

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED: upon the recommendation of the Chancellor and with the concurrence of the Initiatives Committee, the Technology Initiatives Program awards be made in accordance with the list attached and made a part hereof.
