Agenda Item: 3.2 Distribution of Federal Funds Under the Improving Teacher Quality State Grants Program

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Improving Teacher Quality State Grants Program has provided \$2,700,869.00 in FY 2005 federal funds to the Board's Improving Teacher Quality Program; and

WHEREAS, \$2,572,256.00 of these federal funds are available for allocation to projects; and

WHEREAS, \$670,130.76 of unallocated and unspent FY 2004 funds are available for allocation to projects; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals was widely distributed and fifty proposals requesting \$7,283,621.71 were received, focusing on science and mathematics activities for elementary and secondary teachers offered in collaborative arrangements that involve college and university faculty, teachers from high-need school districts, and other professionals from the public and private sectors; and

WHEREAS, a seventeen member Review Panel has reviewed and evaluated all proposals and has make recommendations for the distribution of funds;

NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED: that \$3,237,859.00 of the available \$3,242,386.76 be distributed at follows:
