Agenda Item 3.3 Distribution of Federal Funds under the Improving Teacher Quality State Grants Program

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Improving Teacher Quality State Grants Program, will provide \$2,687,934.00 in federal funds to the Board's Improving Teacher Quality Program during this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, \$2,559,607.00 of the federal funds are available for allocation to projects; and

WHEREAS, \$312,061.08 of unallocated and unspent FY 2001 funds are available for allocation to projects; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals was widely distributed and forty-six proposals requesting \$5,769,196.88 were received, focusing on in-service activities for elementary and secondary teachers offered in collaborative arrangements that involve college and university faculty, teachers from high-need school districts, and other professionals from the public and private sectors and

WHEREAS, a seventeen member Review Panel has reviewed and evaluated all the proposals and has made recommendations for the distribution of funds;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED: that \$2,408,942.08 of the available \$2,871,668.08 be distributed as follows:
