Agenda Item 3.8 Consideration of release and distribution of remaining FY2003 Family Practice and Primary Care appropriations from Amended Substitute House Bill 94 of the 124th General Assembly.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Ohio Board of Regents is mandated by the Ohio General Assembly to administer the distribution of various line item appropriations included in Am. Sub. H.B. 94 of the 125th General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, certain of these funds are provided for a specific purpose and others are to be distributed at the discretion of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Family Practice appropriation of \$6,541,087, reduced 6% by the Executive Order 2002-08T and 2.5% by the Executive Order 2003-01T to \$5,994,906, was created to support education and training to medical students and residents in family practice.

WHEREAS, the Primary Care appropriation of \$3,229,491, reduced 6% by the Executive Order 2002-08T and 2.5% by the Executive Order 2003-01T to \$2,959,829, was created to support education and training to medical students and residents in primary care.

WHEREAS, the Family Practice and Primary Care appropriations are distributed in accordance to a formula that recognizes the number of primary care and family medicine physicians in medical practice.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED: upon the recommendation of the Chancellor and with the concurrence of the Resources Committee of the Ohio Board of Regents, that the FY 2003 appropriations for Family Practice and Primary Care Residencies, as described in the attached table, be approved for distribution.
