

Joint Use Agreement between Owens State Community College and the Village of Holland,  
Ohio

**BACKGROUND**

H.B. 496 includes a specific capital appropriation of \$550,000 to Owens State Community College for a community resource facility located in the Village of Holland, Ohio. The Village of Holland will own and operate the facility constructed with state capital funds. As required by Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Owens State Community College submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State capital funds will support the construction of the Max Albon Center, a community resource facility to be located at McCord Road, Holland, Ohio.

**REVIEW**

Throughout the entire term of the agreement, the Village of Holland will provide the following -

- 1) The Village will share the use of the facility with Owens State Community College. Owens will use the facility for community marketing events, campus business meetings, staff and faculty events, and program training events.

The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

**RECOMMENDATION**

**Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Joint Use Agreement between Owens State Community College and the Village of Holland, Ohio.**
