

Joint Use Agreement between Columbus State Community College and the Jewish
Community Center of Greater Columbus

BACKGROUND

H.B. 562 includes a specific capital appropriation of \$575,000 to Columbus State Community College for a Jewish Community Center of Greater Columbus project. The Center will own the facility to be improved with state capital funds. As required by Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Columbus State Community College submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State funds will support the purchase of an existing facility, located at 150 East Granville Road, New Albany, Ohio, and renovations to this existing facility.

REVIEW

Throughout the entire term of the agreement, the Center will provide the following to the College –

- 1) Use of a multi-purpose room for credit physical activities courses from the College's Sport and Exercise Studies program;
- 2) Use of a library room for non-credit courses in English as a Second Language;
- 3) Use of a conference room for non-credit workshops.

The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Joint Use Agreement between Columbus State Community College and the Jewish Community Center of Greater Columbus.
