

Joint Use Agreement between Cincinnati State Technical and Community College and  
the Mayerson Center/Jewish Community Center

**BACKGROUND**

H.B. 496, as amended by H.B. 420 from the 127<sup>th</sup> General Assembly, includes a specific capital appropriation of \$700,000 to Cincinnati State Technical and Community College for a Jewish Community Center (JCC) project. The JCC will own the facility to be built with state capital funds. As required by Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Cincinnati State Technical and Community College submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State funds will support the construction of a new facility located at 8485 Ridge Road, Cincinnati, Ohio.

**REVIEW**

Throughout the entire term of the agreement, the JCC will provide the following to the College –

- 1) Students of the college will have access to co-operative education opportunities, work-study program placement, internships, and externships at the JCC.

The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

**RECOMMENDATION**

**Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Joint Use Agreement between Cincinnati State Technical and Community College and the Mayerson Center/Jewish Community Center.**
