

Joint Use Agreement between Cuyahoga Community College and the Ohio College of Podiatric Medicine

BACKGROUND

H.B. 562 includes a specific capital appropriation of \$250,000 to Cuyahoga Community College for the Ohio College of Podiatric Medicine (Podiatric Medicine) project. Podiatric Medicine will own the facility to be improved with state capital funds. As required by Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Cuyahoga Community College submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State funds will support the purchase or improvements to the Podiatric Medicine facility, located at 6000 Rockside Woods Boulevard, Independence Ohio.

REVIEW

Throughout the entire term of the agreement, Podiatric Medicine will provide the following to the College –

- 1) Foot screenings from two Podiatric College students, for four hours for each student, under the supervision of residents from the Podiatric College ;
- 2) Eight (8) credit hours of medical assisting experience at the Podiatric College for College students;
- 3) Two (2) credit hours for observations of anatomy dissections at the Podiatric College.

The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Joint Use Agreement between Cuyahoga Community College and the Ohio College of Podiatric Medicine.
