

Joint Use Agreement between Wright State University and the Dayton Regional STEM School

BACKGROUND

H.B. 496 includes a specific capital appropriation of \$750,000 to Wright State University (WSU) for the Dayton Regional STEM School project. The STEM School will own the facility to be improved with state capital funds. As required by Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Wright State University submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State funds will support the acquisition and renovation of a building located near the Miami Valley Research Park in Dayton, Ohio.

REVIEW

Throughout the entire term of the agreement, the STEM School will provide the following to Wright State University –

- 1) The right to use the entire building for pre-service and in-service education and training programs dealing with math and science education;
- 2) The right to assign WSU employees to the facility.

The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Joint Use Agreement between Wright State University and the Dayton Regional STEM School.
