

Amendment to a Joint Use Agreement between Columbus State Community College
and Helping Africans in New Directions

BACKGROUND

H.B. 462 includes a specific capital appropriation of \$100,000 to Columbus State Community College for the Helping Africans in New Directions (HAND) project. The Joint Use Agreement, previously approved by the Chancellor on January 7, 2010, specifies that HAND will own the facility to be improved or purchased with state capital funds. As required in paragraph 12 of the Joint Use Agreement approved by the Chancellor, Columbus State Community College submitted an Amendment to the previously approved Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State funds will support the purchase or improvements to a HAND Community Center facility. The Amendment specifies the facility location will change to 1772 Genessee Avenue, Columbus Ohio.

REVIEW

Throughout the entire term of the previously approved agreement, HAND will provide the following to the College –

- 1) Space to offer educational programs;
- 2) Advertising in the Somali Link newspaper that promotes educational programs;
- 3) Opportunities for College to include educational programs in printed materials.

The Amendment to the Joint Use Agreement will not change these provisions.

The Amendment conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the Amendment is appropriate
- The commitment of the Amendment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions did not change as a result of the Amendment

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Amendment to the Joint Use Agreement between Columbus State Community College and Helping Africans in New Directions.
