

Joint Use Agreement between Rio Grande Community College and the University of Rio Grande

BACKGROUND

H.B. 462 includes a specific capital appropriation to Rio Grande Community College for Basic Renovations projects. The Community College and the University jointly use the facility to be improved with state capital funds. The University either owns or leases space from the Community College. Due to the nature of facility ownership at the Community College and University campuses, following Ohio Administrative Code section 3333-1-03, Rio Grande Community College submitted a Joint Use Agreement for consideration and approval by the Chancellor.

State funds will support the renovation of the Davis Career Center Roof located on the Community College/University campus.

REVIEW

Throughout the entire term of the agreement, the Community College and University will jointly use the Davis Career Center. Given that 100% of the facility will be used for educational purposes, no separate analysis of the value of the project described in the Joint Use Agreement is necessary.

The agreement conforms to Ohio Administrative Code as follows –

- The format of the agreement is appropriate
- The commitment extends no less than fifteen years
- The value of use to Ohio higher education institutions is reasonably related to the amount of the appropriation

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Chancellor approval of the Joint Use Agreement between the Rio Grande Community College and the University of Rio Grande.
