REQUIRED EXPLANATION OF REQUEST

The Ohio Board of Regents respectfully requests Controlling Board approval to transfer a total of \$10,981,887 from Research Facility Action and Investment Funds to the various line items identified on page 2.

The Hayes Investment Fund is used to make selective investments in university research programs to become nationally and internationally prominent in targeted areas and to support Ohio's industrial or community needs. The Hayes Investment Fund stimulates inter-university cooperation and the building of partnerships among university research programs and Ohio industry to create centers of research excellence. Such centers draw upon existing strengths and cost-effectively extend educational and Research and Development benefits to university researchers, students, business, and industry across Ohio.

The fund is used to award grants or interest-free loans for capital equipment and/or facilities. Grants are awarded only to qualifying inter-institutional research consortia. All other awards are made in the form of interest-free loans. Awardees are selected through peer-reviewed, statewide competitions.
