Criteria for Data Collection:

- > Unduplicated headcount
- > Students in degree credit courses only (students auditing degree-credit courses are included)
- > As of the 15th day of classes
- > If a student attends multiple campuses of one college or university, one campus is selected based on preponderant enrollment.

<sup>1</sup> Students at Lakeland Community College taking courses for audit were not included in their 2006 figures. If they had been included, the headcount would have been 8,692, and the percentage increase from 2006 to 2007 would have been 3.5%.
