**BRTTC MEETING SCHEDULED MAY 15, 2002, IN COLUMBUS**

COLUMBUS, OH – The state of Ohio’s Biomedical Research and Technology Transfer Commission (BRTTC) has scheduled its regular quarterly meeting for May 15, 2002, in downtown Columbus.

The commission will select recipients of the 2002 Biomedical Research and Technology Transfer Trust Fund Partnership Awards. The BRTTC and its awards are funded by the 1998 Tobacco Master Settlement Agreement.

The BRTTC program is a key component of Governor Bob Taft’s Third Frontier Project, a sweeping ten-year plan to set Ohio's course for national leadership in the high-tech economy of the 21st century.

The 10 a.m.-3 p.m. meeting will convene in the South A and B meeting rooms on the 31<sup>st</sup> floor of the Verne Riffe Center. The Riffe Center is located across from the Statehouse (at the corner of S. High St. and State St.) at 77 S. High St.
