**OHIO BOARD OF REGENTS TO HOLD MEETING
AT OBR OFFICES IN COLUMBUS, Nov. 14**

COLUMBUS, Ohio – The Ohio Board of Regents will hold its November 2002 meeting at 1:30 p.m., Thurs., Nov. 14, at the agency’s offices, 30 East Broad St., 36th Floor, Columbus, Ohio.

The board will receive an “Update on Proposed Governor’s Commission on Higher Education Funding and Structure” from James M. Tuschman, a member of the University of Toledo Board of Trustees and immediate past UT board chair.

Among items recommended for board action: release and distribution of the FY 2003 State Share of Instruction, institutional reauthorizations, degree program authorizations, joint use agreement considerations and requests to the Controlling Board.

Media and the public are encouraged to attend the 1:30 p.m. board meeting, as well as the 10 a.m. committee meetings, also being held at the agency’s offices.

The Ohio Board of Regents is the coordinating body for higher education in the state. Created in 1963 by the General Assembly, the 11-member public board has a direct, non-governing relationship with all of Ohio’s colleges and universities.
