OHIO BOARD OF REGENTS TO HOLD MONTHLY MEETING AT UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON, DAYTON, OHIO, July 14

COLUMBUS, Ohio – The Ohio Board of Regents will hold its monthly meeting at 1:30 p.m., Thursday, July 14, at the University of Dayton, 300 College Park, Dayton, Ohio.

A highlight of the meeting will be a presentation, titled “University of Dayton: Challenging Minds, Shaping the Future, Embracing Faith and Justice,” by President Daniel J. Curran of the University of Dayton.

Among items scheduled for board action are: consideration of joint use agreements (Clark State Community College and Catholic Social Services of Southwestern Ohio; Clark State Community College and the Champaign Family Young Men’s Christian Association; Sinclair Community College and the National Center for Composite Systems Technology; Clark State Community College and the Tecumseh YMCA Family Center Inc.; and the Ohio Board of Regents and the City of Dublin), a partial release and distribution of FY 2006 appropriations from Amended Substitute House Bill 66, a request by Ohio State University to pledge student fees in support of a debt issuance to finance multiple capital improvements and new projects, academic program authorizations, an institutional reauthorization (Defiance College) and requests to the state Controlling Board.

Media and the public are encouraged to attend the board meeting and the 9 a.m.-noon committee meetings, all being held in the John F. Kennedy Memorial Student Union at the University of Dayton. Parking passes are available for the meeting at the Stewart Street Entrance at the Guard Booth/Visitors Center for Parking Lot P.

The Ohio Board of Regents is the coordinating body for higher education in the state. Created in 1963 by the General Assembly, the 11-member public board has a direct, non-governing relationship with all of Ohio’s colleges and universities.
