**REGENTS SEARCH COMMITTEE TO HOLD MEETING  
May 22 at Regents offices, Columbus, Ohio**

**COLUMBUS, Ohio** – An Ohio Board of Regents subcommittee charged with searching for a chancellor will meet at 10 a.m., Monday, May 22, at board offices, 30 E. Broad Street, 36<sup>th</sup> Floor, Columbus, Ohio.

The subcommittee will consider proposals from agencies seeking to assist the board with the search. The Request for Proposal was made available April 25, 2006. The subcommittee expects to select a firm by the end of June.

At 1 p.m., the subcommittee will entertain input from stakeholders invited to help develop a chancellor profile: ideas and recommendations regarding appropriate responsibilities, duties, experience, skills, strengths and demeanor that would be desired for the next chancellor. The search subcommittee is co-chaired by Regents Bruce Beeghly of Youngstown and Jerry Tatar of Dayton. Regents Jenny Grasselli-Brown of Chagrin Falls and Anthony Houston of Cleveland serve as members of the subcommittee.

Media and the public are invited to attend the meetings.

The Ohio Board of Regents is the coordinating body for higher education in the state. Created in 1963 by the General Assembly, the 11-member public board has a direct, non-governing relationship with all of Ohio's colleges and universities.
