## To View Ohio Board of Regents Video Conference

If you plan to participate in this videoconference, it is our suggestion that you **CONTACT YOUR TECHNICAL SUPPORT STAFF** and ask them to help you test your browser configuration **before** the event occurs.

HINT: Go to [http://sg60.oar.net/OBR\\_Archive/](http://sg60.oar.net/OBR_Archive/) and select any archived session to stream/watch. If this works, you will - most likely - be able to see the conference.

On the day of the event, please type the following into your internet browser: <http://sg60.oar.net/OBR>. Select the current streaming video. Since "Chat" will be enabled, you will be asked to input a screen name. Please use the following format: First initial, Last Name, and 3 initials of your organization. Example: Ken Estep of the Ohio Board of Regents = KEstepOBR.

The requirements are:

- Internet Explorer version 7.0
- Disable pop-up blocker for <http://sg60.oar.net>
- Windows Media Player – you will be prompted for a "plugin". Install the plugin and closeout of the internet. Restart your internet explorer. You may be prompted to install the plugin again, however, it should work after approximately 60 seconds.
- QuickTime - Only version 6.5 or earlier are compatible
- If behind a firewall, you may be prevented from receiving the video stream. You can configure Media Player or QuickTime to receive audio and video streams that are tunneled through HTTP protocol which is usually open in all firewalls. To change your firewall settings: Under "Preferences", change the settings to Use HTTP, Port ID 80. Note: You may want to try the Auto Configure button if your browser version supports it.
- Microsoft Vista is not supported at the moment.
