- From fall 1998 to fall 2007, total headcount enrollments in all sectors of Ohio higher education (public; private, not-for-profit; and private, for-profit institutions) rose by 95,094, a 17.1% increase.
- Enrollment growth patterns vary considerably across types of institutions. Enrollment at public university main campuses increased by 5.2%, from 245,049 in 1998 to 257,818 in 2007. The private, for-profit sector has experienced the fastest percentage growth, increasing by 132.5% over this time period. However, with 31,545 students enrolled in 2007, this sector accounts for about 4.8% of the statewide total.
- The public community and technical colleges grew by 29.1%, from 137,160 in 1998 to 177,107 in 2007. The university regional campuses grew by 16.3%, from 41,883 in 1998 to 48,700 in 2007. The private not-for-profit sector grew by 14.7%, from 119,519 in 1998 to 137,105 in 2008.
- Some institutions are constrained in their growth by capacity limitations related to either physical space or availability of qualified faculty. Other residential campuses are constrained in their growth by state regulation, while some universities are constrained by selective admissions policies.
