¹ The figures reported in this table only reflect changes in tuition from fall term to fall term, and reflect tuition levels in effect as of February 27, 2009.

² Northwest State traditionally increases its fees in the summer term, while all other campuses have their fee increases begin in the fall term. Therefore, in order to comply with the 0% fee cap mandated in H.B. 119 for FY 2008 and FY 2009, Northwest State Community College will hold its fees flat for FY 2009 and FY 2010. Therefore, the colleges FY 2009 fees = \$4,140 represents the first year of their 2 year tuition freeze.

³ These fees represent the estimated average net tuition for in-state undergraduates at Miami University. While Miami's published in-state tuition for continuing undergraduates is \$12,653.64 per semester, all continuing Ohio undergraduates receive an Ohio Resident Scholarship and an Ohio Leader Scholarship for a minimum of \$6,932 per semester (\$13,864 per year). These scholarships reduce Miami's net instructional and general fees for resident continuing undergraduates to a maximum of \$5,721.64 per semester (\$11,443.28 per year). Approximately 60% of all in-state continuing undergraduate students pay below this maximum amount.

⁴ University of Akron's FY 2009 fees include a \$115 per semester transportation fee which is exempt from the fee cap.

⁵ The University of Toledo's FY 2009 fees includes a \$5.20 per credit hour facility fee for the information commons library which is exempt from the fee cap mandated in H.B. 119.
