“Your advisee, Chris Johnson is a student at Local State Community College and has just informed you that she wants to transfer to Large Regional University. Chris wants to know which of her credits will transfer and apply in her intended major and what she needs to do at her new school to complete her General Education Requirements.” Now what do you do?

Representatives from the Ohio Board of Regents Staff will present a double session program to outline the policies and available information associated with questions like the one above. A number of Statewide Articulation and Transfer policies have been developed as mandated by Ohio legislation. These policies affect both student and advisor constituencies at the secondary and post-secondary levels. The policies also will be of interest to advisors working in or helping students with adult, career, and technical education decisions.

The first of the two sessions focuses on the policies and overall program status. The second session focuses on the Articulation and Transfer advising process. A number of advising scenarios will be discussed to demonstrate the policies, information, and tools used in the transfer-student decision-making process.
